May 2024 Grant for the Fife Lake Library Expansion

It was September 1983 and the local financial institution had been going though some changes that had major implications for the Fife Lake area. That is when Rodd Larr and a few local trail blazers decided to start Forest Area Federal Credit Union out of Larr's Sporting Goods Store. At the end of September, the total asset size was \$4,049 and expenses were just \$10. By the end of the year, assets had risen to \$105,321 and served a membership of 147 people.

A lot has changed for FAFCU since that first year. The Credit Union will have seven branches at the conclusion of 2024 serving over 19,000 members. Assets have grown, exceeding a staggering \$250 million. The Credit Union employs over 60 people through the branch footprint.

With all of the changes and growth, there is one thing that has remained constant. The Credit Union is devoted to serving and being a part of our local communities. This commitment has been doubled down on with the addition of our administration building residing in Fife Lake that was launched at the end of 2023. We will continue to double down on this commitment well into the future as we make investments in our communities. We are here to serve you, and that will never change.
