EARLY VOTING INFORMATION FOR FIFE LAKE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS Fife Lake Township Hall - 134 Morgan Street - Fife Lake, Ml 49633

All qualified electors have the right to mark a ballot and deposit the ballot in a tabulator beginning the second Saturday before an election and ending the Sunday before the election, and any additional days prior to the second Saturday before an election that the local board designates.

Early voting will be available at the early voting site for the following hours: Sat, Oct 26 - Sun, Nov 3
